In my time as principal, Eric very rarely ever had a day off. He was the perfect gentleman and a real gentle giant. His daughter Olive has served on the Board of Governors for many years (currently Vice Chairperson) and his grandchildren came through the school. Child Protection Training

Attendance & Illness

Over the last few years due to Covid 19, pupil attendance levels had dropped significantly, however, last year it was great to see an improvement and I am very hopeful that we will see further improvement this year. To this mind, I would really encourage you to avoid taking holidays during term time. As part of DE policy to improve pupil attendance I am required to provide a report to the Board of Governors at each meeting. At Parent/Teacher consultations in October and February your child's class teacher will update you on your child's attendance and if your child's attendance has fallen below 90% you will also receive a letter from myself highlighting the drop in their attendance.

While I really encourage good attendance it is also important that if your child is ill, that they remain at home. Please inform your child's teacher via Seesaw on the first day of your child's absence outlining why they are absent, YOU NO LONGER NEED TO PHONE THE SCHOOL OFFICE AS LONG AS YOU INFORM YOUR CHILD'S TEACHER.

Parent/Teacher Consultations

Please complete the form which will be sent home with your child today indicating which days suit you best to attend for the parent/teacher consultation. Please return the completed form to your child's teacher by Friday 6 October. Teachers will meet on Monday 9 October to co-ordinate days and times for siblings and will use Seesaw to send out consultation days and times on Wednesday 11 October.

The consultations will take place from Monday 23 – Thursday 26 October. To facilitate the consultations, school will finish at 1.45pm (Y1 – Y4) & 1.50pm (Y5 – Y7). There will be no after school activities this week.
